Half-timbered jewel at the confluence of three rivers in the Weser Mountain Region

Once a thriving medieval trading centre at the point where the rivers Werra and Fulda meet to form the Weser, today Hann. Münde is a picturesque town whose half-timbered housing rivals any in Europe. The old town, almost completely surrounded by water, has more than 700 richly decorated half-timbered houses spanning 6 centuries, as well as 12 historic fortified towers, medieval bridges and city walls. The Guelph castle and the magnificent Weser-Renaissance town hall show the wealth of the town.

Modern, interactive water art is a relatively recent addition to the squares of the old town. The numerous picturesque alleyways with half-timbered houses, shops, cafés and restaurants invite the visitor to explore at leisure. Daily boat trips on the three rivers, guided walks of the town, a visit to the last residence of Doctor Eisenbart and his tomb stone or the glockenspiel that sounds daily at 12 midday, 3 p.m. and 5 p.m., together with numerous festivals, give the visitor the opportunity to get to know the most beautiful aspects of the town. A humorous event with theater, music and jugglery taking place in the historic Packhof on specific sundays during the summer months.

From may till october, every saturday at 13.30 p.m., the Doctor Eisenbart invite to his consultation hour in the lower hall of the town hall. The guided tour through Hann. Münde, "on the traces of Doctor Eisenbart", showing places of his life and work, as well as explaining the medicine of Baroque times. During the guided tour with Doctor Eisenbart, he is telling fascinating anecdotes of his life and work.

The Tourist Information office in the historic town hall will give further information about events, guided tours, boat trips and accommodation facilities.
